A quality rock guard that leaves a superb texture that can be made to match virtually any factory texture. CP990/991 is not a lacquer based product such as Kent "Stoney Gray" and 3M "Textured Protective coating", therefore, it does not have a compatibility issue with enamel paints. Lacquer based rock guards may not be applied over enamels or some urethane paints because they will create lifting of the finish. CP990/991 product technology makes it completely neutral to lacquer or enamel. This rock guard will produce a variety of textures according to the number of coats applied. One light coat will produce a light texture, additional coats will increase the roughness of the coating. Unlike many competitive products that produce a grit like surface, CP990/991 produces a smooth yet textured surface that can be buffed without trapping compound. When applying lacquer paint to rock guard there is no need to add flex agent as is recommended with H&H "Tex Cost" and other like products.

Application:

1. Hold approximately 12 inches from surface
2. Move fairly rapid until a consistent texture is achieved
3. Be sure to stop initial coat before product runs
4. Allow five (5) minutes flash between coats
5. Topcoat in 20-30 minutes Wait the full 30 minutes if several coats are applied
